has pleasure in announcing that it is again sponsoring two scholarships to enable promising local government staff to attend the Annual State Conference and Trade Exhibition in 2017, which will be held at the Mercure Sanctuary Golf Resort, Bunbury.

### ***The LGSA WA Inc Annual Scholarship***

will enable a local government staff member, ideally one each from both a country shire and a metropolitan shire, to attend the WA Annual State Conference this year.

However, if it is deemed that there are two outstanding country entrants or two outstanding metropolitan entrants, the scholarships will be awarded accordingly.

The Chief Executive Officer, the Executive Manager Infrastructure or those in a similar management position, are requested to promote these scholarships to members of their staff, and to nominate appropriate staff members by the due closing date. *Please note: these scholarships are not open to current Supervisors or Managers.*

#### ***Essential Criteria:***

- ✓ The nominated person must be a current member of the LGA staff. (employed for at least six months).
- ✓ The nominated person must show a genuine interest in continuing in local government.
- ✓ The nominated person must show interest in progressing towards a leadership role within local government, including continuing professional development.

#### ***Other information, which will assist in the assessment of nominations:***

- ✓ Commitment to working within the community, particularly in leadership/management roles. i.e. coaching junior sport, management role/s i.e. in the P&C / senior citizens / community centre / sports club / environmental group / local hospital.
- ✓ Winners must present a Case Study (short paper) on a topic of their choosing and of general operational interest, at the Annual Conference as part of the 2017 program. *Please note: An outline of this presentation is required with an application, although the topic may be altered prior to the program being printed, if this is approved.*
- ✓ The scholarship pays for Conference registration, accommodation and meals, including the Conference Dinner. If no paper is presented at the Conference, either by the winner or a relevant, delegated presenter, the scholarship may be declared null and void and the LGSA must be reimbursed.
